Portland, OR - Central City Concern (CCC) announces that Elka Grisham has joined the organization in the newly-created position of Self-Sufficiency Project Manager. The position, supported by a grant from The Collins Foundation, will help Central City Concern move forward with a number of new programs designed to speed the rate of self-sufficiency for homeless clients. Programs are designed to reach upwards of 300 people each year.

Ms. Grisham has more than 10 years experience in social service agency work, primarily with domestic violence services in New Jersey. She holds a MSW from Hunter College in New York, and a BA from the University of Iowa.

Central City Concern's mission is to provide pathways to self-sufficiency through active intervention in poverty and homelessness. CCC operates more than 1,300 units of affordable housing and provides health, recovery and employment services to thousands of individuals in the Portland metro area every year.
